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Settlement Exchange System® (SES®) and E-Subro Hub Enhancements – 2024

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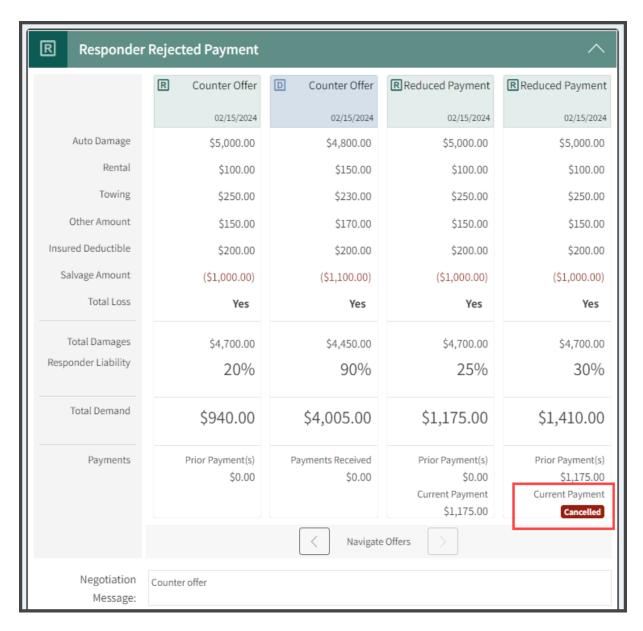


Settlement Exchange System and E-Subro Hub Enhancements – 2024

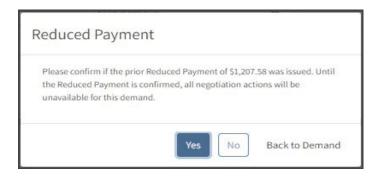
The intent of these changes is to support the expansion of Settlement Exchange System[®] (SES[®]) into Total Recovery Solutions[®] (TRS[®]) and Guidewire products in 2024. Overpayments and revisits to demands will be significantly reduced, if not eliminated, for parties on both SES demands and non-SES demands. From a data perspective, this project will also lead to more accurate, understandable reports and analytics.

Reduced Payments

SES users will be required to confirm if any reduced payments shown as "cancelled" in E-Subro Hub were actually issued outside of SES. This is the same question asked to Responders on non-SES demands.

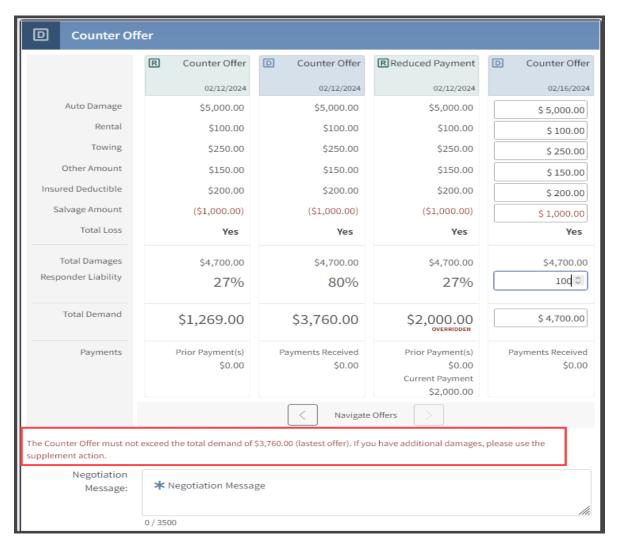






If the Responder confirms that a payment was issued outside of SES, they can send an FYI to let the Demander know and E-Subro Hub will pass the action flag back to the Demander and write the reduced payment activity log.

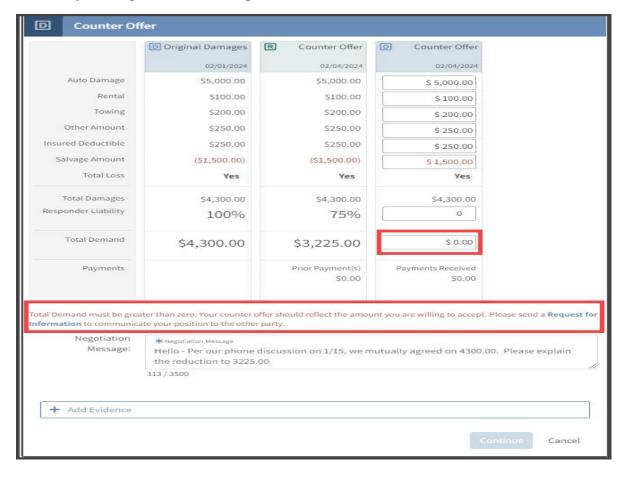
Once there is a valid reduced payment, the total demand on subsequent Demander counter offers can no longer be greater than their last counter offer.

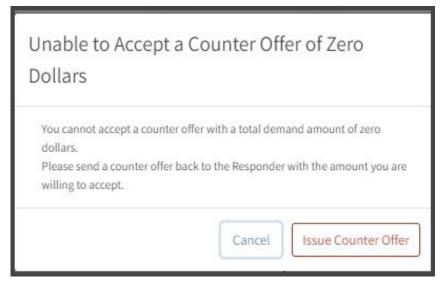




Counter Offers

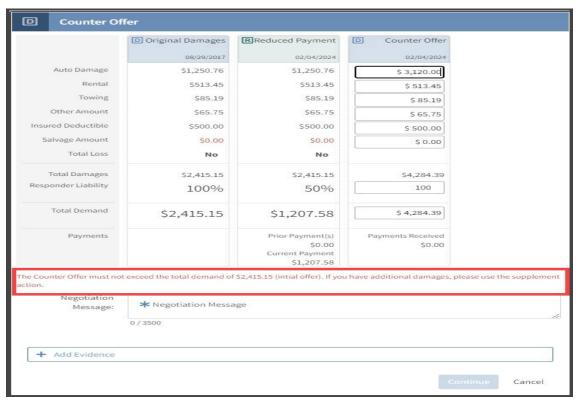
Users may no longer submit or accept counter offers where the total demand is zero.

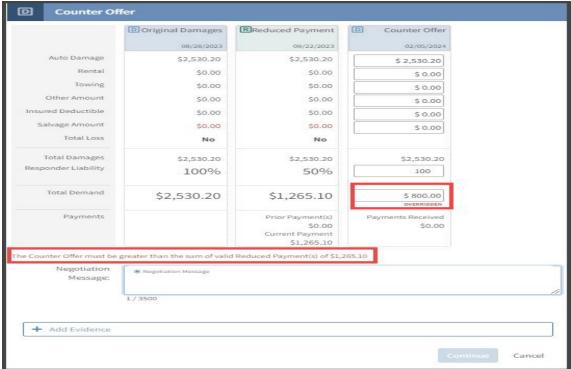






Counter offers may not exceed the total of the original offer or be less than the total of all valid reduced payments.

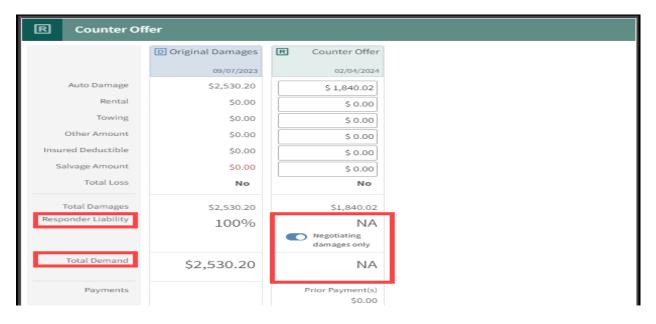


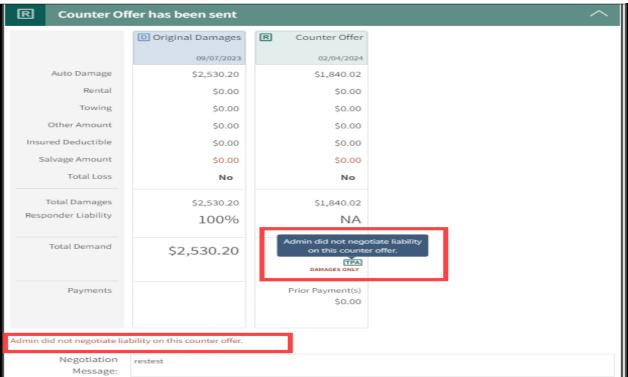




Third-Party Administrators (TPAs)

Third-party administrators (TPAs) may submit counter offers where the total demand is zero when they are negotiating damages only.





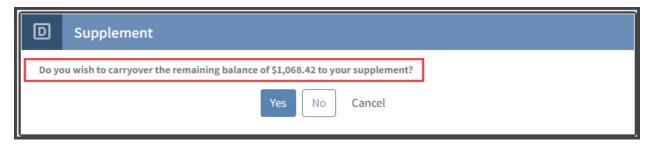


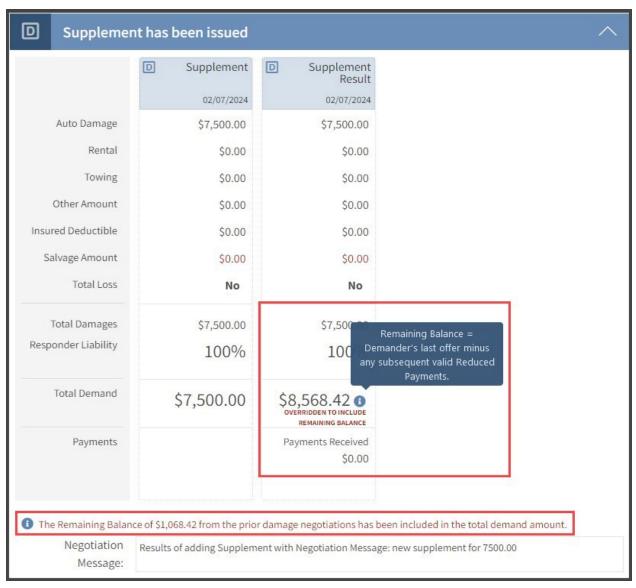


Supplements

Demanders will have the ability to carry over any remaining balance* when there is a supplement and neither party has accepted the prior damages.

*Remaining balance = Demanders last offer minus any valid reduced payments.

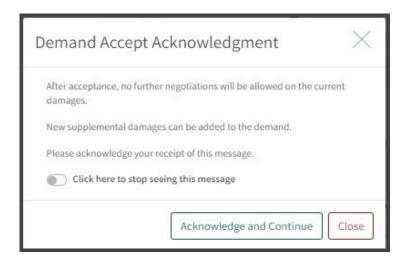






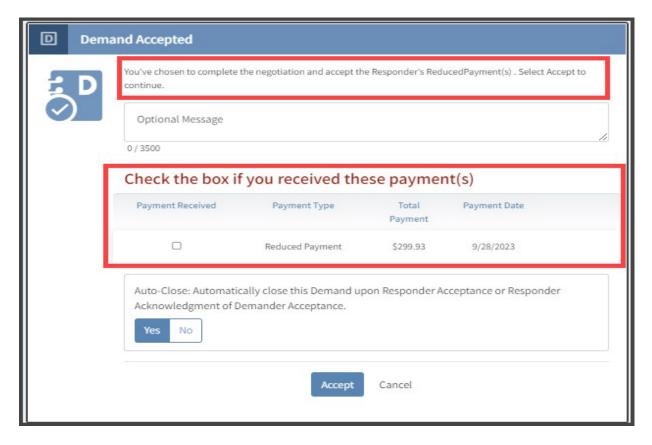
Acknowledge Demand Acceptance

Users will be required to acknowledge "Accept" as the end of the negotiation for the current damages.



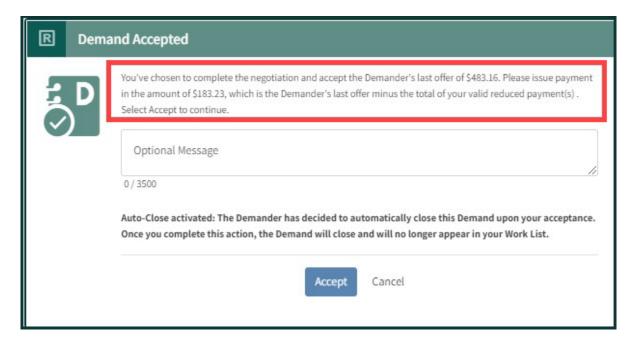
Accept

Demanders may acknowledge reduced payments from within their Accept confirmation screen.



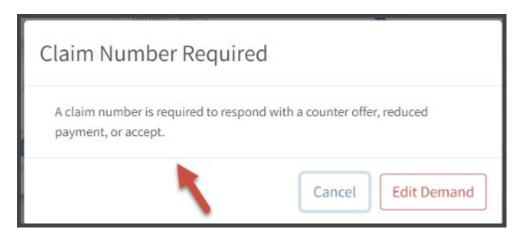


If the Responder takes the "Accept" action after issuing a valid reduced payment, they will be accepting the remaining balance amount for the negotiated damages. If the intent of the Responder is not to pay more after their reduced payment, then a Request for Information should be used instead to let the Demander know their reduced payment is their final offer.



Responder Claim Number

A Responder claim number is required on SES demands to avoid failures when retrieving SES payment IDs. When a Responder takes an "Accept," "Counter Offer," or "Reduced Payment" action and their claim number is missing, it will need to be added before continuing. The Responder claim number can be added on the Demand Details page.





Users will have the same validation rules mentioned in this document applied to inbound commands received by AF. While error codes remain the same, new descriptions may appear. Some examples are:

ErrorCode: 20012

ErrorCondition: ValidationError

Message: Damages information is missing or invalid

Description: The Counter Offer must not exceed the total demand of \$4,700.00

(initial offer). Please use Edit Original Damages (for DI: use command

Correct Demand) if you wish to increase the demand amount.

ErrorCode: 20007

ErrorCondition: SecurityError

Message: Demand is not in required status for this operation

Description: This Demand has already been accepted.

ErrorCode: 10005

ErrorCondition: ValidationError

Message: Invalid data in the user request

Description: Responder claim number is required.
